# New Medical Mileage Rate Effective 7/1/2008: \$.27/mile

While the IRS usually updates annually in the fall, in response to recent gasoline price increases, the IRS has announced an eight-cent mid-year increase in the standard mileage rate for calculating the cost of using an automobile to obtain medical care.

Beginning July 1, 2008, the medical mileage rate will increase from 19 cents to 27 cents per mile.
